Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE)

This training is an in-depth introduction to the neuroscience of early adversity, the ACE study, resilience, and community response to addressing ACEs. This presentation was developed by Dr. Robert Anda, a co-principal researcher of the ACE study, and Laura Porter, Director of ACE Partnerships in Washington State.

Trust Based Relational Intervention (TBRI)

This training is a holistic approach that is multi-disciplinary, flexible, attachment-centered, and challenging. It is an evidence-based, trauma-informed intervention that is specifically designed for children who come from hard places, such as maltreatment, abuse, neglect, multiple home placements, and violence, but you will see that the principles apply to all children. **TBRI** consists of three sets of harmonious principles: Connecting, Empowering, and Correcting Principles, which you will learn about more in this and other training modules.
